

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Nativity Book Project Overview

You are going to build a nativity scene with me, Granpa Cratchet and your family. This will take some adult supervision and while you can do this project in about a total of four hours at one time if you like, you can spread it out on a table and work on it for a week if you want to.

First you'll build your cardboard base out of a project board. Then you'll color and cut all the characters in this Reviving Christmas coloring activity book. Next you'll begin to use them to decorate your set. And when you are finished I want you to take pictures or video of your set and send it to me.

Of course there are the usual characters we know from the Christmas story; Mary and Joseph, the wise men, shepherds, animals and all the other things you'll need to make your set come alive, like rocks, trees and bushes.

Besides what's in this book you and your family can be creative with whatever ideas you have using whatever you can find around your house or garage.

Mom and dad will be reading their book Reviving Christmas, while you build your nativity set. They will be sharing with you about what they read in their book with what you are building on your set.

When it's all done you can send me your photo story or movie you made of your nativity scene and tell the Christmas story in your own unique way. This is a chance to be creative. Will one of the shepherds tell the story? Or will the cow or the donkey or Mary. Just like in a movie someone needs to be the writer, someone the director and someone the editor. After I get your stories I'll put the best ones on Facebook and we'll have our very one movie night with awards, just like at the Emmy awards. I look forward to seeing your story.



Diorama Building Instructions

These first three steps are tough, so you need to work with mom or dad, grandpa or grandma. Also, make sure and watch my Granpa Cratchet how to videos. Then you'll see just what to do and how easy it is to make these part. This is the hard part. When these are done, then you'll just color and decorate. You can see a complete picture of a diorama at the bottom of the next page.


1. Cut your 36" by 48" project board down each of the two folds (1&2).



2. Now you'll make a mark down the middle of the board at 18". Next cut down that line (3) and cut the board in half, so you have part C and D. We'll use part C to make the bottom of your diorama.

3. Next choose one of the wings (A) and cut it to make your backdrop. You'll mark the wing as I show here, measuring from left to right, and then mark the lines. Now score the lines with your Exacto or utility knife, but be careful! Don't cut all the way through on the small dotted lines. If you accidentally do cut it you can tape it back together or use the B side and try again. Only the very last line, the 2" one is to be cut all the way through.


Notice: this board will be 12" tall to begin with. If you would like your diorama to be a little shorter cut it down to 10" longways to begin with and then make these scores. Check out the photos at the bottom of the next page to see a finished diorama.




3. Next fold the board on the cuts to make it look like this. (Here is the top view.) The folds that go against the cut will be a little hard to fold, but work it and it'll loosen up. When you stand this up on the backdrop it will make your scene backdrop and barn.





4. You can make marks on your base (Part C) to guide the backdrop if you like or just position the backdrop on the board as evenly as you can and tape the backdrop to the base. Use masking tape or paint tape, Scotch tape will probably not hold it in place. It works great if you have an extra set of hands. This is a great time to learn how to work together, just like Granpa Cratchet says.



5. And this is the last step in making your diorama, making the top of your barn. Take any leftover piece of the project board and cut out this piece. Place this piece in the center of the barn wherever you like it, about 8" up in the barn and tape it in place. Masking or paint tape works better than Scotch tape.



6. Here's two that I made. The one on the left I cut the back down to 10" and the darker one on the right I forgot to make that cut and it came out taller. Also, you can leave the top straight, or your parent can take the utility knife and make a wavy cut across the top. Remember, make sure and watch my Granpa Cratchet how to videos



Mom and Dad Instructions

These lessons for kids are presented behind the cut out pages and are parallel to the lessons in the Reviving Christmas book for adults. I have called them talks because are designed to help you talk with your child about what is going on in their heart. Listen closely and be very supportive. Building open communication is very important. Take the time to read each talk during the weeks before Christmas. While creating their Nativity scene they can cut out the lessons and staple them together to make a little book. These are designed to bring out what your young person thinks and feels about themselves and their lives. Hear what they say and be sensitive to what the Holy Spirit may want you to say to them. Use this as an opportunity to show them how much you care about them and are there to support them.



They helped me off the floor



Miracle 1 - The Star

Read Matthew 2:9 The star was a miracle! It moved and stood over the Nativity so the wise men could follow it and find Jesus. They didn't have GPS back then. The miracle is that God's Holy Spirit speaks to you, and leads you. Like a GPS (God's Pointing System) the Holy Spirit gives us ideas, insights, and understanding - he shines a light so you can see the way and understand how to live. Read Psalm 18:28 in The Passion Translation. Share a story of a time when God helped you see what to do.

Miracle 2 - The Decree

Read Matthew 2:1-3 Herod's decree is like a presidential order. What the man with authority says goes. God has spoken wonderful things over you. You are loved. You are accepted. You are special. God will never, ever leave you. God will help your life turn out right. God will help you know what to do. What has God spoken over you? Look up Jeremiah 31:3 in the Bible. What does this tell you about what God thinks of you?

Miracle 3 - The Closed Door

Read Luke 2:7. When Mary and Joseph got to Bethlehem there were so many people there was no room for them in the inn. Do you feel like you have been shut out? Have you ever felt rejected? Have you ever felt second best? Has a friend ever told you they don't want to be friends anymore? Jesus is the best friend a boy or girl could ever have. Jesus will never, ever turn you away no matter what. Read John 3:16,17. Talk about how to feel good about how much God loves you when others don't love you.

Miracle 4 - A Cave Is Chosen

Read Luke 2:7a. Since there was no room in the inn Mary and Joseph had to stay in the barn with the animals. This was most likely a sheep cave in the side of a hill. They must have felt really bad to have their baby in a dirty place with animals. Sometimes we feel this way about our lives. We don't like where we are. We want to be somewhere else. Share a time when you felt this way. Know that even when times seem dark that God is with you. Read Hebrews 13:5b. If God helped baby Jesus, He will help you too.

Miracle 5 - The Manger

Read Luke 2:12 Baby Jesus was laid in a manger, which was a feed bin for animals. It was a very humble beginning for Jesus, who was God, who was King of Kings and would save the world. It tells us He came not as special person, but as a common person, just like you and me. He knows what it is like to be humble. Do not be upset when someone puts you down. You are not what they say you are. You are what God says you are. Share a time when you felt put down. Read Isaiah 57:17. God loves those who are humble.

Miracle 6 - Travelers From Afar

Read Matthew 2:1,2 The wise men traveled a long way to see Jesus. They were very smart and very wealthy men. What do you think about you? Do you think you are smart? Do you think you are special? Have other kids ever put you down, like you weren't as good as they were? No matter what anyone says about you, you are smart and very wealthy if you seek to know God. Knowing God is the most important thing you can own in life. What does John 10:10 tell you God wants to do for you?

Miracle 7 Angels Speak

Read Luke 2:8-15 God sent an angel to Mary to help her prepare for her future. Did you know that God has angels that help Him take care of you? Angels are all around you to help you and protect you. Share a time when you were really scared. What should you do when you are afraid? Read Matthew 18:10.

Miracle 8 - A Mother Is Chosen

Read Luke 1:26-38 God has a mother. Her name is Mary. Your relationship with your mother is very important. What good things does your mother do for you? What can you do to show your mother that you love her? If you lose your mother God shows he loves you by providing another person to be your mother and they can love you like their own. Who would that be to you? Read John 14:18

Miracle 9 - A Father Is Chosen

Read Luke 2:4a - Father's are very important people in our lives. They work for us and provide for us. Sometimes kids loose their fathers or they move away. Has that happened to you? If you have lost your dad God will be your dad and He will always work to provide you with another dad who will love you and care for you on Earth. They will be your dad and you will be their son. Has this happened to you? How do

Miracle 10 - Herod's Fury

Read Matthew 2:16 Herod got very angry when he thought Jesus was going to take away his throne and kingdom and so he tried to kill Jesus. Just like Herod, the devil hates you and wants to take your life. But Jesus defeated the devil by dying on the cross and the devil can hurt you only if you believe his lies. God says you are loved. If you have asked Jesus into your heart God says you are forgiven and are His friend. What kind of lies does the devil try to tell you? Who will you listen to? Have you


Miracle 11 - Bethlehem Is Chosen



5. If you want the inn door to open and see the grumpy inn keeper you can have your parent cut the left door and then just Scotch tape down the left side of the door for a hinge. Color, cut out and paste the inn keeper behind the door on the back of the diorama.


